PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, and Overhead \$ 350

THE FOLLOWING DISCLOSURE IS REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION: Our charge includes, but is not limited to, staff and facilities to respond to initial requests for service 24 hours every day; consultation with the survivors; coordinating service with crematory and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased; sheltering of the deceased; accounting; regulatory compliance; legal and audit fees; postage, printing and supplies; telephones; insurance; salaries and benefits for our staff; various local, state, and federal taxes and fees. This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

THE FOLLOWING DISCLOSURE IS REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION: Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

DIRECT CREMATION

This charge includes the basic services of funeral director and staff, facilities, overhead and Automotive equipment to carry out the local transfer of the deceased to a holding facility, temporary shelter of remains by refrigeration, filing of death certificate and securing disposition permit. It also includes up to a one hour consultation with family, crematory charges and return of cremated remains to the arrangement office. It does not include viewing of the deceased or any funeral ceremony.

If you wish to arrange for Direct Cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials with an outside covering. The alternative containers we provide are made of fiber-wood and cardboard.
